Contact me to schedule your visit and I'll reserve the time for you... no charge. Be sure to come prepared for a day in nature (ask if you are unsure what that means). All we require is that if you need to enter our home for any reason (bathroom, for example), you wear a correctly fitted mask until you are back outside.

The hubby and I will stay out of your way unless you want to visit with either of us and then we will keep the appropriate distance (and mask if you like).

You are welcome to help harvest (i.e. pick your own) and get a discount because you are doing work I won’t have to do. **Check to see if I have frozen berries/fruit after the season. I often do.**
